FEDERAL GRANTS

- **BUILD** – Better Utilizing Investments to Leverage Development
 - Federal transportation grants
 - Greater than \$1 Million
 - Most communities provide 20% to 50% match (no match officially required)
 - Benefit-Cost Analysis Required
 - About 5% of applications are funded
- **Northern Borders Regional Commission Grants**
 - Up to \$500,000 for infrastructure projects
 - 50% Match Required (NEK – 20%)
